Project Presentation (video and additional materials)	Only the delegations that selected full projects instead of 48 hr projects.	<p>Every team should prepare a project presentation where they showcase the environmental work they have undertaken. All projects must be sent in a prerecorded video. If you are attending in person you will most likely present live, but you are still required to send the prerecorded video since we will use it for the virtual modality. If you are coming in-person, also make sure to submit any materials you will use to present (like a slideshow, flyer, script, etc)</p> <p>Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Your presentation should explain your CEI project and how it links to the theme of the conference. - Videos should be maximum 10 mins - If you introduce yourselves, make sure to only use your first names or nicknames for privacy reasons - Follow the general video guidelines <p>It doesn't necessarily have to be a slideshow! To be presented along with the other countries' videos during the conference. All performances must be sent in a prerecorded video. If you are attending in-person you will most likely present live, but you are still required to send the prerecorded video since we will use it for the virtual modality.
